Students learn from other students.

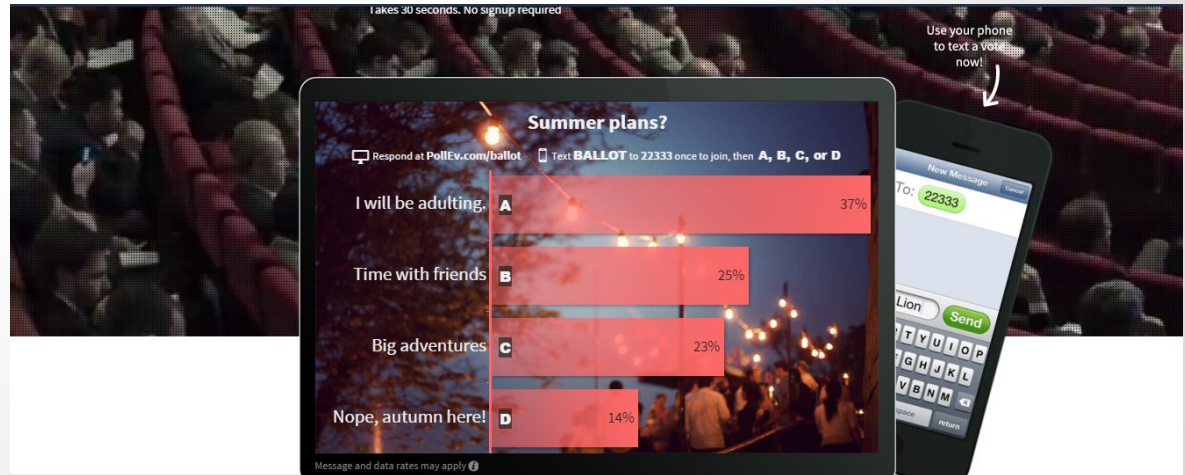
Students see various models of note-taking.
