The annual report highlights the accomplishments for Year 2020 by the CPMEF Board members continued to serve but activity was minimal while monitoring the transitions of the various CPM organizations that continued after the AACPM merger into ASPA.

#### Board Accomplishments for 2020.

***Due to Covid-19 issues impacting CPM activities in 2020 there was minimal activity by the CPMEF.***

- 1. Communications:** Communications with AACPM Board in effort to re-establish relationship post ASPA.
- 2. Funding Resources:** In 2018 to Oklahoma CPM Society voted to disband and graciously donated their cash balance to CPMEF. This will allow CPMEF to continue to fund the OSCPM Phyllis Taylor Scholarship. In addition, it will support the Wilkinson and Lemons Scholarships and program awards for continuing education. Previously the Arizona CPM Society disbanded and donated over two-thousand dollars of their cash balance.
- 3. Scholarships:** The Fran L. Wilkinson Scholarship, funded initially by AACPM in 2020 in the amount of \$750, was awarded to Mark Bodanza (NH) via reimbursement to AACPM. The Jack Lemons Scholarship and Phyllis Taylor Scholarships were not awarded in 2020. The CPMEF Board received, and funded a Program Award application from AACPM to fund CPM training sessions for 53 individuals at the 2019 AACPM Conference in held in Omaha Nebraska.
- 4. Bylaw updates:** The board continued to rely on the changes to the 2013 Bylaws which updated the Purpose of the CPMEF to support CPM affiliated organizations with a membership of 60% or greater CPM's.



5. **Program Awards:** The CPMEF Board received, and funded a (\$1,500) a program award application from AACPM to fund CPM training sessions for 53 individuals at the 2020 AACPM Conference in held in Omaha Nebraska and a (\$750.00) reimbursement for the Wilkinson Scholarship it initially funded.
6. **Cash Donations:** In 2020 CPMEF received cash donations totaling \$ 0.00, from individual donors. During the 2016-2020 period the costs to maintain the CPMEF web site and domain registrations were provided as in-kind by the Executive Director.
