Board Accomplishments for 2021.

Continuation of Covid-19 issues impacting CPM activities in 2021 limited CPM training activity.

- 1. Communications:** Communications with AACPM Board was re-established and the executive director was invited to participate in several zoom meetings.
- 2. Funding Resources:** Due to the donation in 2018 by the Oklahoma CPM Society CPMEF was able to fund Scholarships and program awards.
- 3. Scholarships:** The Fran L. Wilkinson Scholarship, funded by AACPM in 2021 in the amount of \$750, was awarded to Shalon Bogard, from Arkansas. The Jack Lemons Scholarship and Phyllis Taylor Scholarships were not awarded in 2021. The CPMEF Board received, and funded, a Program Award application from AACPM to fund on online CPM training session as the 2021 AACPM Conference
- 4. Bylaw updates:** The board continued to rely on the changes to the 2013 Bylaws which updated the Purpose of the CPMEF to support CPM affiliated organizations with a membership of 60% or greater CPM's.
- 5. Program Awards to Societies:** The CPMEF Board received, and funded (\$1,500), a program award application from AACPM to fund a portion of the speaker fee for a zoom training session. Actual fund transfer will occur in January, 2022.



6. **Cash Donations:** In 2021 CPMEF received no cash donations from individual donors. In-kind donations valued at \$500.00 were received.
